All full paper submissions will be peer-reviewed and evaluated based on originality, technical and/or research depth, accuracy and relevance to the workshop topics.

The paper length is limited to 5 pages, including references. All submitted papers must be strictly prepared following the publication guidelines:

Organization of the manuscript

Each manuscript should have:

Title: TNR 12 bold. Capitalize the first word only.

Authors and affiliation: TNR 12 Italic, with first and middle names or initials followed by surname. If multiple authors have the same affiliation, one listing of the affiliation should be used, preceded by the full list of those authors on the line above.

Abstract: TNR 10, regular. The authors prepare a structured abstract of not more than 300 words.

Key words: TNR 10, Italic. Immediately after the abstract, provide a maximum of 3–6 keywords. Key words should refer to the terms from Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) of MEDLINE/PubMed.

Main text (Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion): TNR 11, regular.

References: TNR 10 regular

For the references, use APA style (American Psychological Association). The list of references should include only those publications which are cited in the text. References should be presented in alphabetical order. No more than 30 references will be accepted.
